

Monday, January 27—Exodus 28-29

According to Ex.29:44-46 the presence of the Tabernacle in the midst of Israel was a continual reminder of what reality? What did it signify to the children of Israel?

Tuesday, January 28- Exodus 30-32

What does Moses' prayer for the people (Ex.32:31-32) demonstrate with respect to his leadership of the people? What does it indicate concerning his role and relationship to the people? What does this indicate concerning spiritual leadership among the people of God?

Wednesday, January 29- Exodus 33-35

What does God reveal concerning Himself in the declaration of His name in Exodus 34:6-7? What does this indicate concerning His manner of dealing with man? How does God deal with us (see also—Psalm 103:11-18)?

Thursday, January 30- Exodus 36-38

What was the manner with which all who worked on the construction of the Tabernacle did their work (Ex.36:2)? What does this indicate concerning the kind of service that is pleasing to the Lord?

Friday, January 31- Exodus 39, 40

Notice chap.40:1-33- this section is arranged in two major division: 1-16 God's commands concerning the setting up of the Tabernacle; 17-33 the setting up of the tabernacle. 14x in the second section we find the phrase "*as the Lord commanded Moses.*" What might this be intended to communicate?

Saturday, February 1- Leviticus 1-4

What is the qualifying character of the burnt offering mentioned in Leviticus 1:3? How is it to be offered? What does this indicate concerning the motivation for offering the burnt offering—this act of worship to the Lord? What does this suggest concerning our own worship of God?

Sunday, February 2- Leviticus 5-7

What does the precision of these instructions concerning the sacrifices convey concerning the worship of God; that which God requires of His people in coming to Him?
