When we think about the fact that, by their redemption from Egypt, the People of Israel were God's people to live in God's place (that is, in his presence), under God's rule enjoying God's blessing and that in order to enjoy that blessing they must abide by God's rule, what do the events recorded in these chapters indicate is going to be the future of their relationship with God?

Tuesday, February 18—*Numbers 14-15*

What was at the heart of Israel's refusal to enter the land and what was the consequence of that refusal? How does what happened at Kadesh Barnea mirror what happened in the Garden of Eden?

Wednesday, February 19- *Numbers 16-18*

What do the Israelites continue to demonstrate in their actions toward Moses and toward God? What lies at the root of this and what does it indicate regarding their need?

Thursday, February 20- *Numbers 19-21*

What do we learn about God's character from the various events recorded in these chapters?

Friday, February 21- *Numbers 22-24*

What do these chapters reveal about who is in control of Israelites affairs? Who is governing what is happening to them and what does this indicate about that one?

Saturday, February 22- *Numbers 25-26*

What does Israel demonstrate once again in the incident at Baal Peor? What does this reveal about the heart of the people? What does this reveal about their essential need?

Sunday, February 23- *Numbers 27-29*

What does Moses request of God in Numbers 27:16-17? What does this request indicate about basic human nature and man's basic need?
