Thursday, February 27- Deuteronomy 1-2

How is the sovereign providential governing in the affairs of mankind demonstrated in these chapters? What broader principles and truths can we discern from these examples?

Friday, February 28- Deuteronomy 3-4

What warning does God give the people in Deut.4:9 and what does it suggest about our propensity with respect to the things of God? What safe guards should be establish in order to avoid this pitfall?

Saturday, March 1- Deuteronomy 5-7

According to Deuteronomy 6 how was God's will for His people to be fostered and passed along among them? What instructions did God give particularly to parents? What does this suggest ought to be our practice as believers in Jesus Christ?

Sunday, March 2- Deuteronomy 8-10

What practical understanding and instruction are we given in Deuteronomy 8:11-20, particularly as it relates to how we should understand the things that we possess and how it is that we make provision for ourselves? What implications does this have for how we should understand ourselves?
