What do we learn of God's steadfast love and covenant loyalty from Deut.30:1-10?

**Tuesday, March 10—Deuteronomy 32-34**

What does Deut.32:39 declare concerning God? What implications does this have concerning how we think about God? How we live before Him?

**Wednesday, March 11—Joshua 1-4**

What was the ground of Joshua's confidence as he led the people of Israel in to possess the Land (see Joshua 1:9; cp. Ex.3:12)?

**Thursday, March 12—Joshua 5-7**

Consider the *fear of the Lord* in view of Joshua 7; what does this account teach us concerning how we fear the Lord? What is the measure of the "fearsomeness" of God? To what extent is He to be feared? Does grace mitigate the fear of the Lord (see 1 Pet.1:13-21)?

**Friday, March 13—Joshua 8-9**

How is the Blessing of God upon the obedience of the children of Israel demonstrated in the conquest of Ai?

**Saturday, March 14—Joshua 10-11**

In what way does Israel reap the fruit of their sin with the Gibeonites and in what way does the Lord demonstrate His loving kindness toward Israel in the situation with the kings of the Amorites? How does this instruct and encourage you with respect to the consequences of sin and the loving-kindness of God?

**Sunday, March 15—Joshua 12-14**

How does Caleb's personal experience reflect the covenant relationship between the Lord God and the children of Israel (Joshua 14:7-9)?
