Monday, April 6, 2020- *1 Samuel 25-27*

How does the Lord show his kindness and care for David in the situation with Nabal and Abigail?

Tuesday, April 7, 2020- *1 Samuel 28-31*

Notice the contrast between Saul and David in this final scene of the conflict between the two men: what are some of the elements of this contrast? What is the key difference between the two?

Wednesday, April 8, 2020- *2 Samuel 1-3*

How does David show wisdom in this early stage of his reign after the death of Saul? How does he deal with the news of Saul's death? How does he handle the situation with Abner?

Thursday, April 9, 2020- *2 Samuel 4-7*

2 Samuel 7:12-16 contains what is called the Davidic Covenant—God's promise to David. What are the elements included in the Davidic Covenant? What is the time frame for these promises?

Friday, April 10, 2020- *2 Samuel 8-11*

What are the two elements involved Joab and Abishai's battle with the Ammonites and Syrians (2Sam.10:12); what are the two components of what is taking place in that situation? What are the implications of this reality for our own lives?

Saturday, April 11, 2020- *2 Samuel 12-13*

What are the first bitter fruits of David's sin with Bathsheba that he received as the Lord said?

Sunday, April 12, 2020- *2 Samuel 14, 15*

What is the significance of David's sending the ark of the covenant back into the city of Jerusalem and continuing into the wilderness without it (2 Sam.15:24-29)? What was the significance of the Ark of the Covenant? So, for David to be separated from the ark was to be separated from what (see Psa.63)?
