

Thru the Bible- April 27-May 3* **1 Kings 20-2 Kings 14*

Monday, April 27- *1 Kings 20, 21*

How does God demonstrate His mercy to Ahab (1 Kings 21:29)?

Tuesday, April 28- *1 Kings 22, 2 Kings 1*

What was the Word of the Lord concerning Ahab (1 Kings 21:19) and how was this word remarkably fulfilled? How is the superintending hand of God in the affairs of man demonstrated in the account of Ahab's death?

Wednesday, April 29- *2 Kings 2-4*

Notice in 1 Kings 2:19 and following how those who honor the man of God and who look to him for aid are blessed, but that those who despise the man of God are cursed: it is apparent through this that during the time/ ministry of Elijah and Elisha that the role prophet of God became very significant in the life of God's people.

Thursday, April 30- *2 Kings 5-7*

Notice once again how those who look to the man of God with hope are blessed, but that those who despise the word of the man of God suffered lose.

Friday, May 1- *2 Kings 8, 9*

Notice God's providential care of the Shunammite woman (8:1-6): How does God providentially care for her? What circumstances unfold that open the way for her to obtain her land back? What other instances in the OT does this reflect (see: Ruth 2:3; Esther 6:1-10)

Saturday, May 2- *2 Kings 10-12*

How is Joash's reign framed in terms of the Deuteronomic covenant (2 Kings 11:12; see: Deut.11:18-20)

Sunday, May 3- *2 Kings 13, 14*

Notice the graciousness of God toward Jehoahaz when he cries out to the Lord because of oppression (2 Kings 13:4-5); what does this indicate concerning the character of God (see. Ex.34:6-7)
