1 Chronicles 7-29

Monday, May 11- *1 Chronicles 7-9*

Note: 1 Chronicles 9:1—what happened to Judah and why (cp. Deut.28:1-2, 14)

Tuesday, May 12- *1 Chronicles 10-12*

Notice David's actions upon receiving the water from the well in Bethlehem which his men had obtained by breaking through the Philistine line (1 Chron.10:18-19): what do these actions indicate concerning the significance of what they had done and concerning David's character?

Wednesday, May 13- *1 Chronicles 13-16*

What does the striking incident with Uzza and the ark indicate concerning the character of God and how he is to be regarded by those who come before Him (Lev.10:3)?

Thursday, May 14- *1 Chronicles 17-19*

What was the chief reason David desired that what the Lord had spoken concerning him be brought to pass (1 Chron.17:24)?

Friday, May 15- *1 Chronicles 20-23*

Which of the three options for punishment did David choose in the incident of the census? Why? What does God reveal concerning Himself in this incident?

Saturday, May 16- *1 Chronicles 24-26*

Notice the simple statement in 1 Chron.25:5—*"For God gave Heman fourteen sons and three daughters."* What do these words indicate concerning Heman's sons and daughters? What do they indicate is the Biblical understanding and perspective with respect to those things that we would call our own? What are some implications of this?

Sunday, May 17- *1 Chronicles 27-29*

Notice David's prayer (1 Chronicles 29:11-19): what does it reveal concerning God; concerning man's blessings; concerning man's giving to God?
