### Wednesday, June 3- Nehemiah 4-6

What was the anchor for Nehemiah's heart and mind in the face of the challenges he encountered throughout the process of rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem? What was his reminder to the people throughout the work?

## Thursday, June 4- Nehemiah 7, 8

What did the people who had returned to Jerusalem and Judah do that had not been done since the days of Joshua, Son of Nun?

# Friday, June 5- Nehemiah 9, 10

Nehemiah 9 is a prayer of the Levites that rehearses the faithful working of God in the history of the nation of Israel: take note of the character of God revealed through His dealings with the nation.

# Saturday, June 6- Nehemiah 11-13

What do the reforms that Nehemiah was required to make concerning the observance of the Sabbath and the marrying of foreign wives indicate concerning the hearts of the people even after the exile?

# Sunday, June 7- Esther 1-3

Notice God's gracious provision and providential care of His people.
