Job 29-Psalm 31

Monday, June 15- *Job 29-33*

Consider Job 32:8; in view of this statement what truth does the very act of breathing set before us? What are we reminded of every time we draw a breath?

Tuesday, June 16- *Job 34-37*

What does Job 34:14-15 indicate about the providential care and provision of God? What does it suggest about the idea of man being "*independent, self-sufficient*" in any real sense?

Wednesday, June 17- *Job 38-42*

Consider the statement made in Job 38:36; What does this indicate concerning the source of wisdom? In view of this statement what does the existence of wisdom indicate? The fact that wisdom/ understanding, intelligence exists testifies to what?

Thursday, June 18- *Psalms 1-9*

Psalms 1-9 is the cornerstone of the Psalms; it strikes a cord that runs throughout the entire collection. What is that cord? What is the central thought of this Psalm?

Friday, June 19- *Psalms 10-17*

Often in these Psalms the Psalmist is calling out to God for deliverance; he speaks of putting his trust in God. What things do we learn about the Lord God in these Psalms that engenders and encourages such confidence?

Saturday, June 20- *Psalms 18-22*

There are many tremendous statements in these Psalms concerning the Lord God, His person and His works; What do these Psalms about Who God is? How do they fill in the blank, the Lord is _____? What does this mean for our response to God?

Sunday, June 21- *Psalms 23-31*

These Psalms speak many times of God as our refuge, strength, deliverer; what does this teach me about the Lord God? What is the effect of recognizing God as refuge upon the Psalmist?
